

## GUIDELINES ON HOW TO FILL THE FORM

Please follow the guidelines to fill up the Technical elements table order.

1. Use the column 'Element Code' to write the code of the element that you can choose from the list that follows.
2. Use the column 'Notes' for some particular situations that need explanations.
3. It is not necessary to know which steps or features are chosen by the skaters, it is just needed the code.
4. You can specify the level of the elements in the 'Note' field but it is not mandatory.
