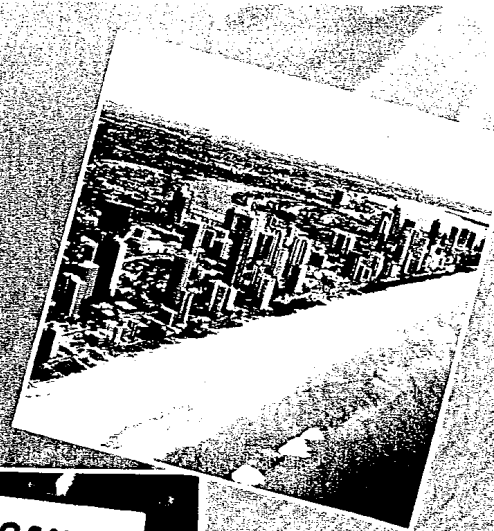
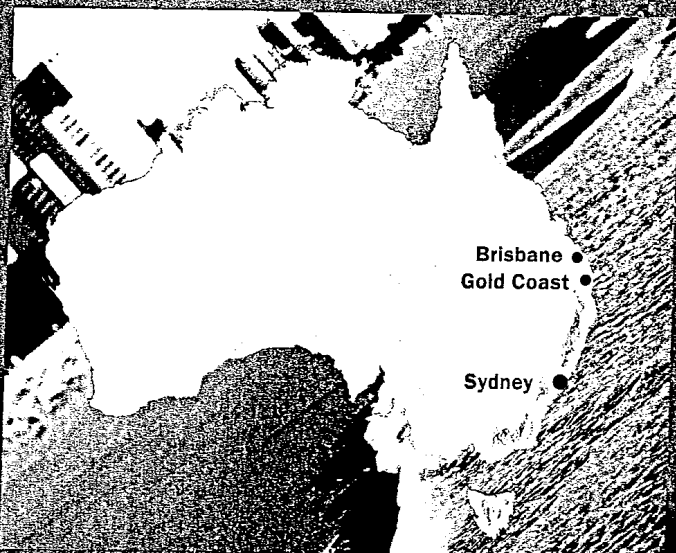
October and November are beautiful months with temperatures in the 23 to 25 Celsius range.
